## **Electric Mobility**

- 36,68,544 electric vehicles are registered in India (as on 05-02-2024).
- 16,348 operational Public EV Charging Stations in India currently.
- India's EV market is expected to expand at a CAGR of 45.5% between 2022-2030, with the segment's volumes set to cross annual sales of 16 Mn units by 2030.
- 100% Foreign Direct Investment is allowed under this sector under the automatic route.

## **Government Support**

- Production Linked Incentive Scheme on Advanced Chemistry Cell (ACC) to boost local manufacturing of advanced chemistry cell to bring down prices of battery as well as reduce the cost of electric vehicles.
- Charging stations do not need a separate licence under the Electricity Act of 2003 as charging for the purpose of charging an electric vehicle is classified as a service.
