The Embassy of India, Bangkok is commemorating Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel from 25-31 October 2021. Birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the first Deputy Prime Minister and Home Minister of India is observed as "Rashtriya Ekta Diwas" (National Unity Day) on 31 October, every year since 2014.
